

Ceramics at the Arc Centre

Arc has a dedicated ceramics studio/workshop, providing the opportunity to make, store and fire ceramic artwork. The studio measures 6.4 x 4.5 m and depending on the activity can accommodate up to 8 people. The facilities are suitable for holding workshops, and booking space independently, or collectively for use by *emerging and developing potters*.

Equipment includes:

- Four Cowley P6340 throwing wheels
- Two Potclays series 6 Kilns located in a neighbouring kiln room
- Heavy duty shelving and storage space in both studio and kiln room

We would love to hear from experienced and emerging potters who would like to:

- Share a ceramics workspace in the studio for up to 4 people at any one time (volunteer technician support available)
- Offer pottery workshops - daytime, evening or weekend, from beginners to master classes as part of the Arc Public programme.
- Book the studio for your own students, and having your sessions advertised on Arc's website and publicity.
- Use our kilns at competitive rates

- **Bookable individual workspace £48 for 12 hours access within our opening times**

- **Kiln firing at £25 per kiln**
